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Introduction

Goals/Objectives

- ChartertoConductor would like to Incorporate a start of next year as non-profit 501(3) a. Hold fundraisers at Parrish Florida for Revenue to Pay for Independent School license for accredited with the Florida Department of Education. Choose or Elect Board of Directors. Apply for Federal and State Domestic Grants for year 2018 upon announcements. Establish a Budget and Plans for an Audit for the First Fiscal Year. Establishing Course Catalog with FRRM as Campus. Function on Total Volunteer Basis.
- First conferencing hold a meeting with Parrish, Florida for the Board of Directors of ChartertoConductor and Florida Railroad Museum on a course of action. Will determine the Proceedings for the Fiscal Year 2018 and Project details. For Program cost and reporting done, revenue accounts, fiduciary funds, balance accounts, internal service funds, funds, expenditure and cost of services provided.

 Provide that we incorporate and Partner with FRRM Organization. On Articles of Dissolution that the Nonprofit Corporation under IRC be given to Florida Railroad Museum

Founding Ideas

My lead proposal is for Florida Gulf Coast Railroad Museum Inc. for Campus, Center, special purpose center and instructional site designation (F.A.C. 6A-14.0061). Find facilities to rent of public or post-secondary institutions following State Requirement of Educational Facilities for classrooms. An advantage to renting public schools is they can provide the administration for your school.

Special United States Army Corps Engineering with FRA Rehabilitation Loans under CFR 36 VIII part 800 contracts for protecting and repairing historical railroad.

Provide Statements of Work for Administrators' dealing with contracts, accounting, and legal issues. A statement of work for the Administrative staff, dealing with students and directors.

The committee will develop policy pertinent to school program and will assume the overall supervisory responsibility for training. The committee will coordinate training for students and faculty. The committee will execute program support requirements. Develop budget estimates and manage and execute the annual budget. Provide Instructions for payment of school related expenses.

6a-10.015 FAC Appointment of Committees

The Boards, Organization or PA to hold a monthly or bi-monthly conference over program implementation. Changing and revising existing Articles of Incorporation. The conference is to record the minutes in the agenda with theory of compliance of minutes of the meetings. The meetings will be followed by a conference report.

Given that the apprenticeship curriculum, classroom study hours equate to 500 hours of reading book plan. Course conversion to or Modification FAC 6A-6.05291 for being accepted college for a degree.

Grant that Parrish committee conforms to a secondary school service agreement FAC 6A -1.0403 or Industry Certification FAC 6A-60.537. Also, ChartertoConductor may want to become accredited with the Accredited Council of Independent Colleges and Schools. Is a 6 month application process after submission. Any way you look at whether it be an apprenticeship or some kind of school there is a first year audit and visit.

Student Fee are as follows out of Florida red book; permit excess fee, tuition, fund for services, student services, adult covered education and course fees, post-secondary vocation fee, continue workforce education fee, post-secondary lab fees and other general fees.
