


### .. Preface ...

## DESCRIPTION OF STYLE "F" MOTOR MECHANISM.

In 1893 THE HALL SIGNAL COMPANY brought out an automatic semaphore signal operated by an electric motor. This was the first signal of this type commercially introduced, and although somewhat crude and faulty in design, showed the possibilities of electric motor signaling. For the past twelve years this company has steadily improved the mechanism used in motor signals. By far the most important step made in this steady progress was the introduction in the year 1905 of the style "F" electric motor semaphore signal.

This improved signal is, in many of its details, a modification of the mechanism of the well-known Hall electrogas signal with the power furnished by a motor instead of by gas. The same direct vertical action is attained which makes possible the highest degree of efficiency in action and simplicity in design. The parts are comparatively few in number and are made strong and durable. The possibilities of a derangement of any kind seem remote, and the chance of a complication that would give a false clear indication is infinitely small.

An extraordinarily small amount of current—less than 10 milamperes—is required to hold the signal in the clear position. This small battery consumption is attained by the long leverage used in the clutch lever. Nor is this battery saving attended by any increase in the possibilities of a false clear indication since no toggle joints or off-centering of the mechanism is employed. Nothing could be simpler or safer than this dog and latch arrangement here used.

The Hall Company has developed an electric motor of higher efficiency than any before used for signaling. This motor runs without load on .5 of an ampere. The maximum current consumed during the clearing of the signal

is 1.8 amperes. With this slight battery consumption it clears both blades of a double arm signal in 15 seconds. (See pages 406 and 408.)

Roller bearings are used on the shafts of the mechanism and in the stud rollers on the gear wheel 14.41; ball bearings are used on the motor shaft. This reduces the loss of energy by friction to a minimum, which allows the use of heavy counterweights (insuring the gravity return to danger position during any extraordinary condition of ice, frost or other impediments) without any undue waste of energy.

A striking and important point about this apparatus is the adjustment of the angle at which the stud rollers meet the thrust piece 14.100. This angle is such that the maximum load is carried at the point of maximum leverage, and the same proportion is quite nicely carried through the stroke. To demonstrate this (before a number of signal experts at the International Railway Congress at Washington in May, 1905) a battery of 4½ volts was connected to the signal. This amount of power was just sufficient to start the signal moving, and yet, without a catch, it slowly moved the entire distance to the clear position. With this design a signal at "half-cock" is impossible. The force increases from a ratio of 1 to 250 in the first part of the movement to 1 to 500 when the signal reaches the clear position.

The Hall style "F" electric motor signal is the simplest, most reliable and efficient mechanism of this type ever designed. It is equally well adapted for use on primary or storage battery circuits. It is adapted to either the normal danger or the normal clear system. It is easily adapted to any desired angle of blade movement and to two or three positions. One of the most important features about the mechanism is the convenience of taking any part of the mechanism off or replacing it. By removing two screws the clutch magnets may be taken out, or by removing three screws the thrust rod and dash pot, with the parts attached, can be taken out, and all screws are convenient to get at.

In the detailed description of the design and action of this mechanism which follows, the right hand side of the mechanism will be referred to. The same description would apply to the left hand side by substituting the numbers of that side. The cast iron base 14.08 supports the motor, clutch coils, pistons of the dash pot and the frame 14.05. This frame supports the side frames 14.06 and 14.07, and they contain the roller bearings for gear shafts 14.36 and 14.37, and support the clutch levers 14.11 and 14.12. The steel thrust rod 14.13 is rigidly pinned to the cylinder of the air dash pot 14.29. The base 14.08 has two pedestals rigidly attached, which support the pistons for the dash pots. The piston, in conjunction with the cylinder 14.29, forms the guide for the lower end of thrust rod 14.13; the upper end of this rod runs in a babbitt bearing in the frame 14.05. Secured to the thrust rod 14.13 is the latch support 14.96, which carries the clearing lever 14.22, the thrust piece 14.100, and the latch which engages the lug on the clutch lever 14.11, to hold the signal clear. The thrust piece carries the latch 14.33, which engages the lug on clearing lever 14.22. The large gear wheels are phosphor bronze, and they are driven by the steel pinion 14.193 on the motor, and the pinion and shaft 14.37.

The phosphor bronze knife blade contacts of the circuit controller 37.210 are operated by the circuit controlling rod 14.49 and the escapement crank 14.47. The escapement crank is controlled by the roller 14.52 attached to the latch support. The front armature on the clutch magnets control the multiple contacts for the motor circuit. The back armature is attached to the clutch lever 14.11, which enables the magnets to control the clutch lever. The motor 14.150 is series wound. The fields are laminated iron with but one joint, which is dove-tailed, making them practically continuous, and reducing the magnetic loss on account of joints to a minimum. The armature and commutator are completely enclosed by means of a brass case over the armature and a glass cover over the commutator. The glass cover is held in position by two springs bearing on two lugs on the glass, and all that is necessary to take the cover off


is to turn it enough to move the lugs from under the springs. To replace the cover, hold it in position and turn it far enough to bring the lugs under the springs.

When the home signal is at danger the circuit controller contacts for the motor are closed and the contacts controlling the distant clutch magnets are open, so it is impossible for the distant signal to clear until after the home is clear. When the home signal clutch magnet is energized it closes the motor circuit through the contacts on the front armature, and at the same time holds the back armature, which prevents the clutch lever moving when pressure is applied to clear the signal. The motor circuit being closed, the motor revolves the gears and brings the stud roller 14.38 under the thrust piece 14.100 and pushes it up. Since the clutch lever 14.11 is held by its armature, it prevents the clearing lever 14.22 swinging back and by means of the lug on this lever engaging the latch 14.33 in thrust piece 14.100 carries the thrust rod and all the parts attached to the clear position. In moving to the clear position the roller 19.20, pivoted in the lower end of clearing lever 14.22, rolls along the front edge of clutch lever 14.11. In the last one-eighth inch movement of the signal to the clear position the roller 14.52 strikes the short lever of the escapement crank 14.47 and moves it on to its pivot 14.56, and by means of the rod 14.49 operates the circuit controller, opening the motor circuit and closing a contact in the distant signal circuit. The signal is held in the clear position by the lug on the clutch lever 14.11, engaging under a latch on latch support 14.96; this leaves the gears free to continue their movement as soon as the distant clutch magnet is energized to clear the distant signal. After the signal has been cleared the stud roller 14.38 moves from under the thrust piece 14.100. When the signal circuit is broken the clutch magnet is de-energized. The front armature opens the motor contacts to keep the motor circuit open, and the back armature being released permits the clutch lever 14.11 to swing back far enough so the holding latch in the latch support 14.96 can pass the lug on the clutch lever and allow the signal to go to danger by gravity. The movement of the signal to danger is cushioned by the air dash pot 14.29. The circuit controllers are reversed as soon as the signal starts to danger. If by any chance the motor circuit should be closed without the clutch magnets being energized, the motor would simply revolve the gears, and when the stud roller engaged the thrust piece it would raise it without effecting the signal, on account of the clearing lever 14.22 being free to swing back and permit the latch 14.33 to pass it. When the stud roller passed from under the thrust piece it would drop back in place and be ready to clear the signal when the clutch magnet is energized. Or if the clutch magnets should become de-energized when the signal was partly clear the clearing lever 14.22 would be permitted to swing back on account of clutch armature being released and allow the latch 14.33 to pass the lug on the clearing lever. The signal would go to danger, the thrust piece 14.100 would remain on top of the stud roller by swinging on its pivot 14.104, and when the stud roller moved from under it, it would drop back in its place, ready for another operation.

The signal rod is connected to the thrust rod by means of the clamp 14.24.

Attachments are also furnished so that the blade cannot be cleared from the outside; as, for instance, in case of workman painting blades and clearing signal when train is in block.






Style "F" Mechanism for two blade Signal



Style "F" Mechanism for two blade Signal






Bracket Masts for Automatic Signals
